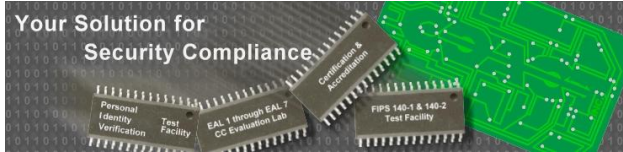

Certification & Accreditation

The Federal Information Security Management Act (FISMA) of 2002 requires that all U.S. federal agencies certify and accredit (C&A) all information systems and major applications that are put into production on U.S. government networks. COACT's C&A department has proven expertise in helping U.S. federal agencies comply with FISMA and improve their annual Federal Computer Security Report Card scores. Whether your agency requires assistance in setting up a C&A program, enhancing the program you already have, certifying new information systems, or validating new C&A packages, COACT can help.

COACT, Inc. CAFE Lab

The COACT CAFE Lab is an independent test facility accredited by the National Voluntary Laboratory Accreditation Program (NVLAP), under Lab Code 200416-0, to perform Common Criteria validations, FIPS 140-2 testing, Personal Identity Verification (PIV) testing, and SCAP Testing.

Common Criteria Testing Laboratory

Since 2000, COACT has been a National Information Assurance Partnership (NIAP) Common Criteria Testing Laboratory (CCTL) and has successfully completed Common Criteria evaluations on a wide range of technologies including firewalls, intrusion detection and prevention systems, operating systems, databases, printers, copiers, wireless gateways, and encryptors/decryptors. The COACT CAFE Lab performs evaluations on products, Security Targets, and Protection Profiles and is the only CCTL to have performed two (2) EAL7 evaluations.

FIPS 140-2 Testing Laboratory

The CAFE Lab is accredited under Lab Code 200416-0, through NVLAP, the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) and the

Communications Security Establishment (CSE), for test methods of FIPS 140-2, for Cryptographic Modules, and for testing of FIPS-approved algorithms.

Personal Identity Verification (PIV) Testing

The CAFE Lab is also accredited under Lab Code 200416-0 through NVLAP, NIST, and CSE to test both PIV client middleware and PIV on-card applications. PIV smart cards are physical access cards that may also be used for access to IT systems. These are dual interface smart cards conforming to ISO 7816 for contact interfaces and ISO 14443 contact-less interfaces.

SCAP Compliance Testing

The COACT CAFE Lab is a third party independent testing facility accredited by the National Voluntary Laboratory Accreditation Program (NVLAP Lab Code 200416-0) to perform SCAP compliance testing. The Security Content Automation Protocol (SCAP) is a method for using specific standards to enable automated vulnerability management, measurement, and policy compliance evaluation (e.g., FISMA Compliance).
